I. Call to Order

C. Friends of Spectrum, Inc. Board Meeting Minutes – January 14, 2020

On a motion duly made and seconded, Gangl/Anackerl, the Friends of Spectrum, Inc. Board of Directors unanimously approved the Consent Agenda as presented.

VI. Ongoing Business



A. Budget Report

Mr. DeBruyn shared that he asked Amy White, Business Assistant, to complete an analysis of fundraising funds to be transferred from Spectrum to Friends of Spectrum, Inc. He stated that there is approximately \$36,870 in athletic funds, and approximately \$7,800 in other funds, such as National Honor Society, Prom, etc., for a total of approximately \$45,000 that will be transferred after July 1, 2020. He will be working with Nick Taintor to finalize the amounts and determine the best time and process for transferring the funds. It is planned that the funds will be transferred all at one time and utilizing only one check. Once transferred, Ms. White will disburse the funds within the Friends of Spectrum, Inc. account exactly as the funds are currently parsed within the Spectrum account ensuring that the funds remain with the respective sport and/or activity for which they have been raised.

Next, Mr. DeBruyn stated that a Credit Card and/or Bank Card for the Friends of Spectrum, Inc. account is currently in process of being secured and will be used to make purchases from respective funds. He stated that it will be in place in time for athletics to make purchases for fall sport's and that Mr. Peterson will be working closely with Ms. White ahead of making purchases to ensure that the correct account is debited. Checks are currently available for FoSI to make purchases and provide reimbursements as well.

B. Executive Director's Report

Mr. DeBruyn shared that he provided most of the Executive Director update during the Budget Report portion of the meeting. He also stated that Spectrum's Sting Swing has been postponed until spring of 2021 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

C. Athletic Director's Report

Mr. Peterson provided a brief report for the Board. He stated, as noted previously, that purchasing and planning for fall sports begins in the summer, and that he will working closely with Ms. White regarding athletic purchases. He went on to state that he has held several meetings with coaching staff to explain Friends of Spectrum, Inc. (FoSI) vs. Spectrum, and how purchasing will be handled moving forward. He noted that most everyone is understanding why the FoSI entity has been created, which allows for more flexibility with athletic and activity purchases. He also highlighted that baseball is currently in the negative, but will be balancing the account before any further purchasing.

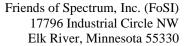
A. Sting Swing Update
