1. Note and purchase all supplies required of all high school students, plus any course specific supplies listed below.
2. This is a basic supply list and additional supplies may be required as listed on the course syllabi.
3. Students should be prepared with all school supplies at Open House or on the first day of school.
4. The majority of school/home communication and much of students' daily work requires computer and internet use at home. On the first day of school, all students will be provided a school-owned Chromebook computer for the school year – for use at home and school. Students and parent(s) will be required to sign off on the equipment and insurance will be made available through the school (recommended). No student-owned electronic devices will be supported or allowed to be used in classes.
