Course Registration for 2018-2019

The portal will be open from Monday, March 12th, 2018 – Friday March 23rd, 2018.

- Students will register online for 2018-2019 courses. Directions can be found on the website under For Students > Guidance Office > Class Registration.
- Guidance office will enter required courses. Required courses and elective choices should equal **16 semester classes** (A year-long course equals 2 semester courses).
- Students should **also enter four alternate choices** in order of preference. **Do not put year-long courses as alternates.**
- For students who need assistance or do not have access to a computer at home, the guidance staff will be available on the following days to assist you.
